



Reconstruction of Driveways Along State Road 326 at Pilot Travel Center & Mobil Gas Station

Marion County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be reconstructing driveways that service the Pilot Travel Center and Mobil Gas Station along eastbound, or the southside of, State Road (S.R.) 326 at the Interstate 75 Exit 358. Improvements also include the reconstruction of asphalt, curb, gutter, and sidewalk work as well as other miscellaneous activities associated with this type of project.

What to Expect

Access to businesses will be maintained by the contractor during work activities. Each driveway will be reconstructed one at a time. The driveway directly servicing the Mobile Gas Station and the driveway that services commercial truck traffic leaving the Pilot can be closed for a 48 hour time period to complete work. The shared driveway can only be closed on one weekend to complete work from 7 p.m. on Saturday to 7 p.m. on Sunday. No lane closures are allowed on S.R. 326 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Safety

Electronic message boards and other signage will be posted to help direct drivers to businesses and around work zones. Temporary structures and signs will also be in place to safely direct pedestrians and bicyclists around work.

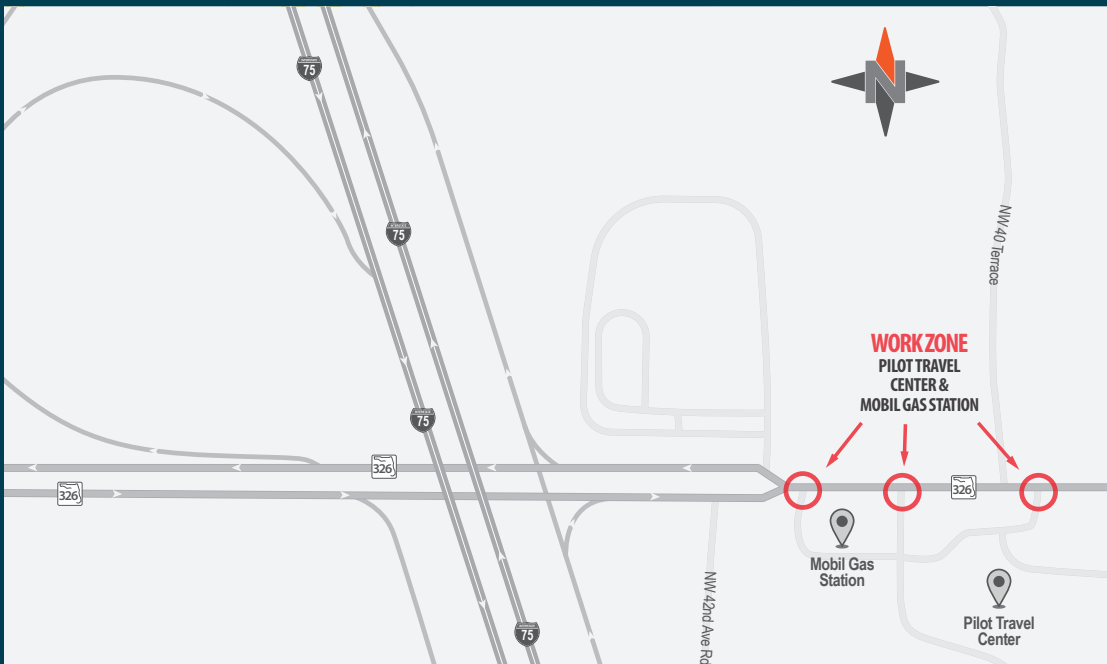
