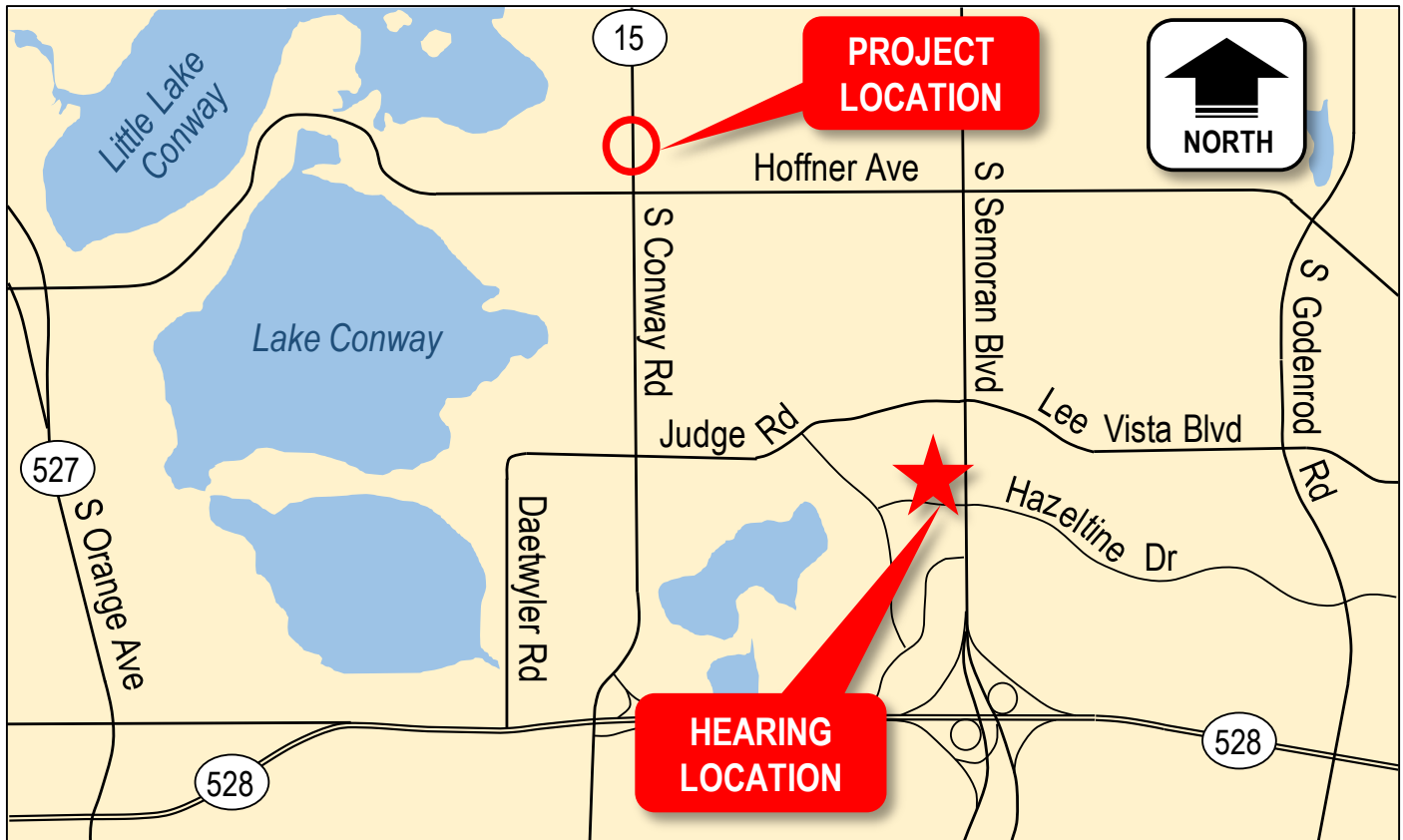




NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**STATE ROAD (SR) 15/South Conway Road
North of Hoffner Avenue, Orange County
Safety Improvements - Median Modification**

Safety improvements are proposed on SR 15/South Conway Road just north of Hoffner Avenue at the north Conway Crossing/Belle Isle Commons shopping plaza driveways, in Orange County. The project addresses crash patterns in the area by converting the full median opening to a directional median opening. This modification reduces traffic conflict points at the location, improving safety.

This public hearing is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements. Draft project documents will be available for public review from September 27, 2016 to October 28, 2016 at the Orange County Southeast Branch Library, 5575 S. Semoran Blvd., Orlando, FL 32822.

Participants may provide verbal comments directly to a court reporter before and after the formal presentation. Persons wishing to submit statements, in place of or in addition to oral statements, may do so at the hearing or by sending them to:
