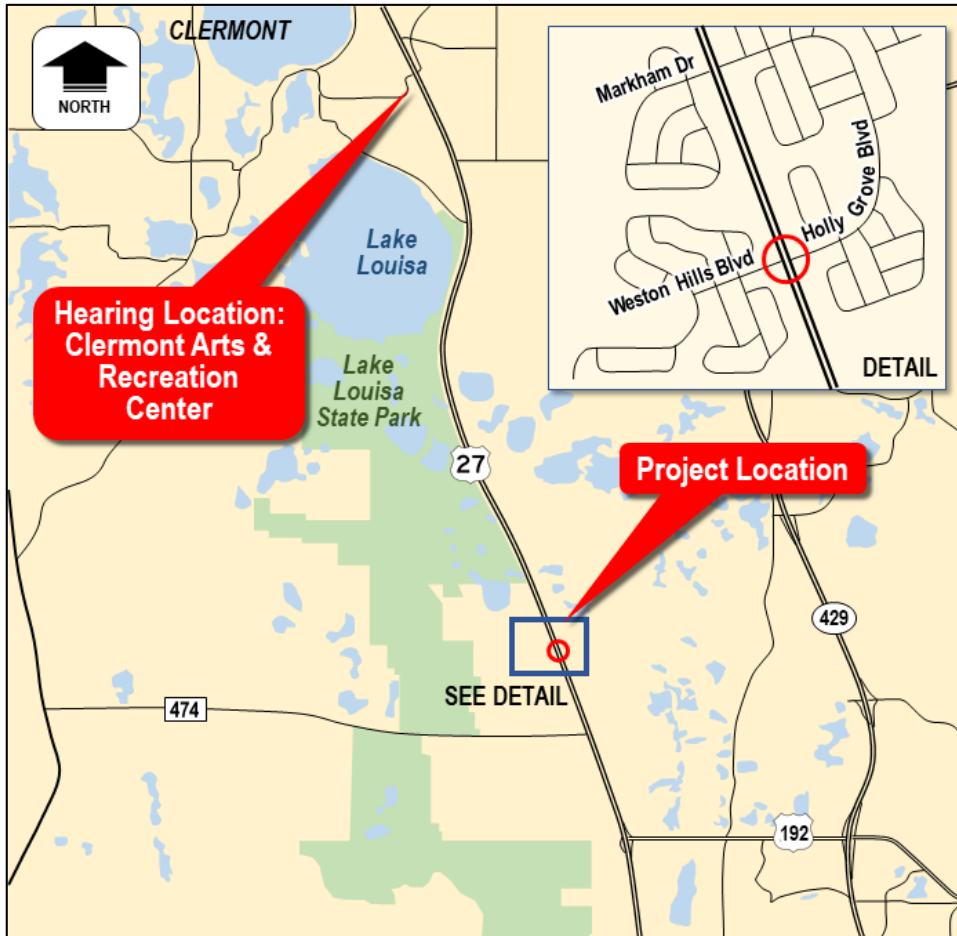




# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Florida Department of Transportation will conduct a public hearing for the proposed safety improvements on U.S. 27 at the intersection of Weston Hills Boulevard/Holly Grove Boulevard. The project addresses operational and safety concerns in the area by converting the full median opening to a bi-directional median opening. Left turns from U.S. 27 onto Weston Hills Boulevard and Holly Grove Boulevard will still be permitted, and sight lines will be improved due to the lack of vehicles stacking in the median. Traffic entering U.S. 27 from both of the side streets will be converted to a right turn only lane. These modifications reduce the number of conflict points at the intersection, which improves safety.

This public hearing is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements. Draft project documents will be available for public review from May 29 to June 29, 2018 at the Cagan Crossings Community Library, 16729 Cagan Oaks, Clermont FL 34714.

Participants may provide verbal comments directly to a court reporter before and after the formal presentation.
