



# Interstate 75 Weigh-in-Motion Station Repairs between County Road 484 (Exit 341) and the Sumter County Line

## Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be repairing concrete at both the northbound and southbound weigh-in-motion stations along Interstate 75 (I-75) in Marion County located between County Road 484/Exit 341 and the Sumter County line, adjacent to the SummerGlen community. Improvements under this contract include pavement reconstruction within the stations as well as along I-75 northbound and southbound acceleration lanes, pond work, updating lighting, signs, and pavement markings, and various pedestrian features to comply with the current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

## What to Expect

Construction will require each weigh station to close, with work finishing on one station before the other can close.

## Safety

Electronic message boards and other signage will be posted to notify commercial truck drivers that the station is closed. Advanced notice will also be provided to direct traffic around work on I-75, if needed.


