

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The purpose of this project is to perform bridge bearing pad rehabilitation work on the eastbound Oakridge Boulevard and westbound Seabreeze Boulevard (State Road (S.R) 430) Bridges over the Halifax River. A bridge bearing pad is the part of the bridge that provides a resting surface between bridge piers and the bridge deck. The bearing pad reduces friction.



WHAT TO EXPECT

This project will require single eastbound lane closures on the Oakridge Boulevard (S.R. 430) Bridge, as well as single westbound lane closures on the Seabreeze Boulevard (S.R. 430) Bridge over the Halifax River. Lane closures will happen during daytime and nighttime hours. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of closures.
