

I-95 at U.S. 1 Interchange

Plantation Oaks Boulevard/Broadway Avenue to Destination Daytona Lane

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing improvements for the interchange along Interstate 95 (I-95) at U.S. 1 (exit 273) in Ormond Beach. The project also plans enhancements along U.S. 1 between Plantation Oaks Boulevard/Broadway Avenue and Destination Daytona Lane.

The design proposes a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) configuration, which improves operations and safety at the interchange by reducing conflict points for left-turning vehicles. A DDI also increases left turn capacity, minimizes traffic queues and eliminates existing substandard loop ramps.

The project proposes widening U.S. 1 from two lanes to three in each direction, and adding shared-use paths to serve bicyclists, pedestrians, and other users.

The project design follows the recommended alternative from the recently completed Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study.

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
