

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing operational improvements on Silver Springs Boulevard (State Road 40) from Pine Avenue (U.S. 441 / U.S. 301) to NE 25th Avenue.

The purpose of this project is to extend the service life of the existing roadway by repaying all travel lanes on Silver Springs Boulevard within the project limits. This project also includes updating pedestrian curb ramps in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

This project will be constructed with two other adjacent projects on Silver Springs Boulevard from NE 25th Avenue to NE 64th Avenue (FPID No. 450951-1) and from NE 64th Avenue to the Lake County Line (FPID No. 450948-1).
