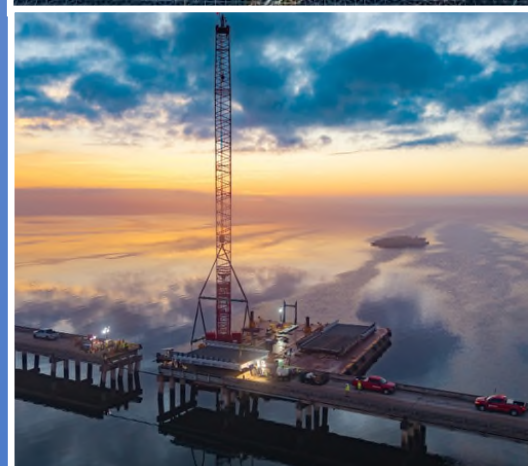
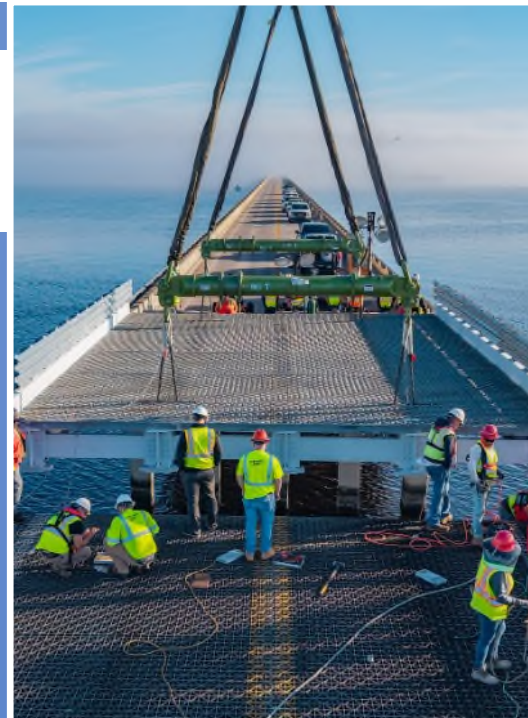
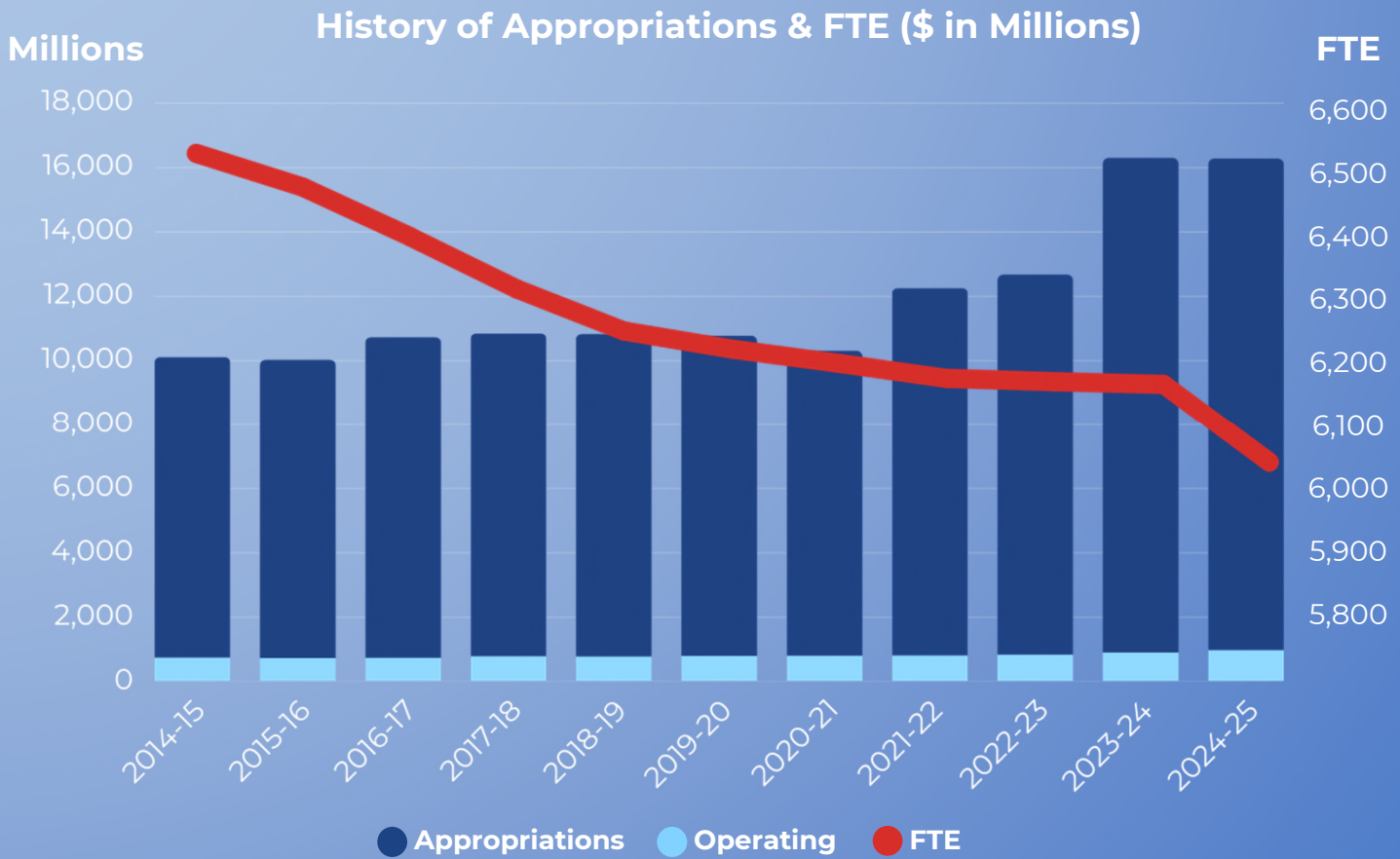


FDOT Revenue Forecast of Receipts

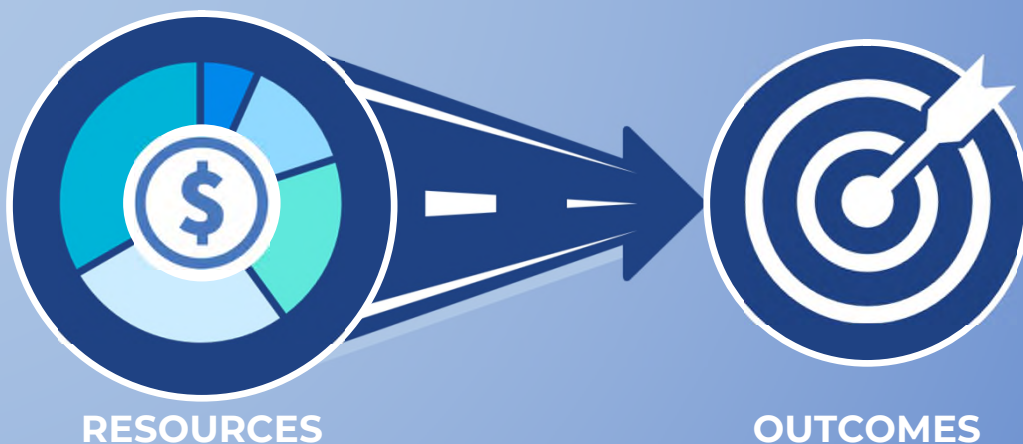

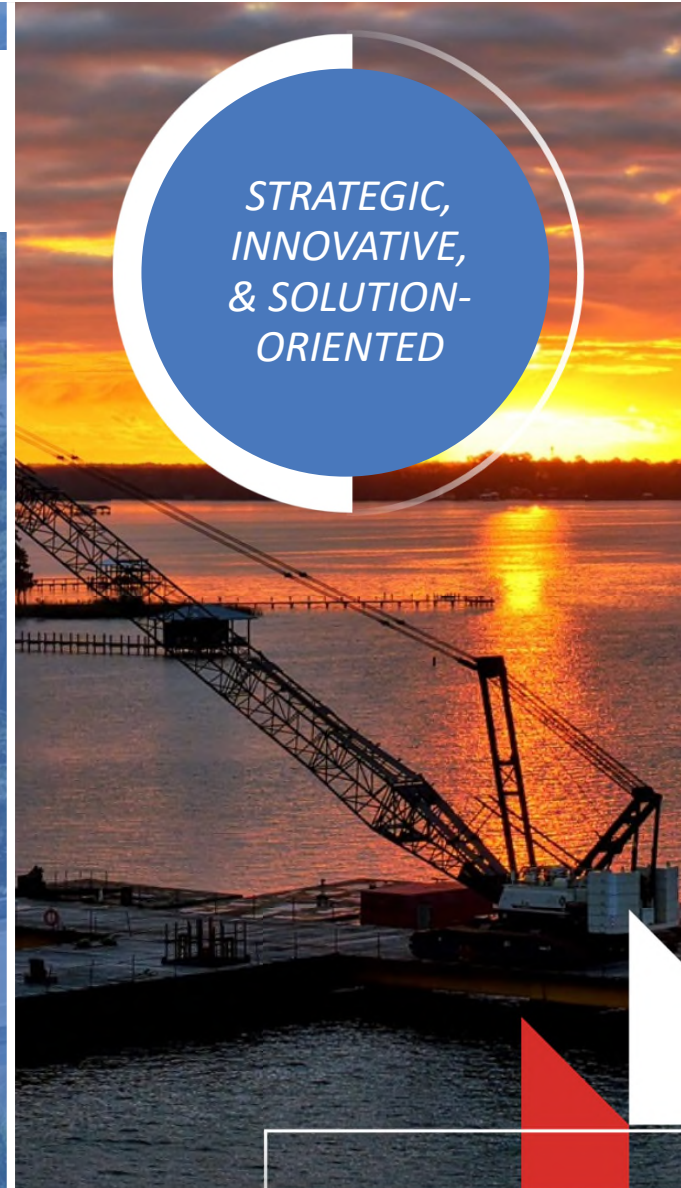
