



S.R. 40 Safety Improvements at SW 27th Avenue

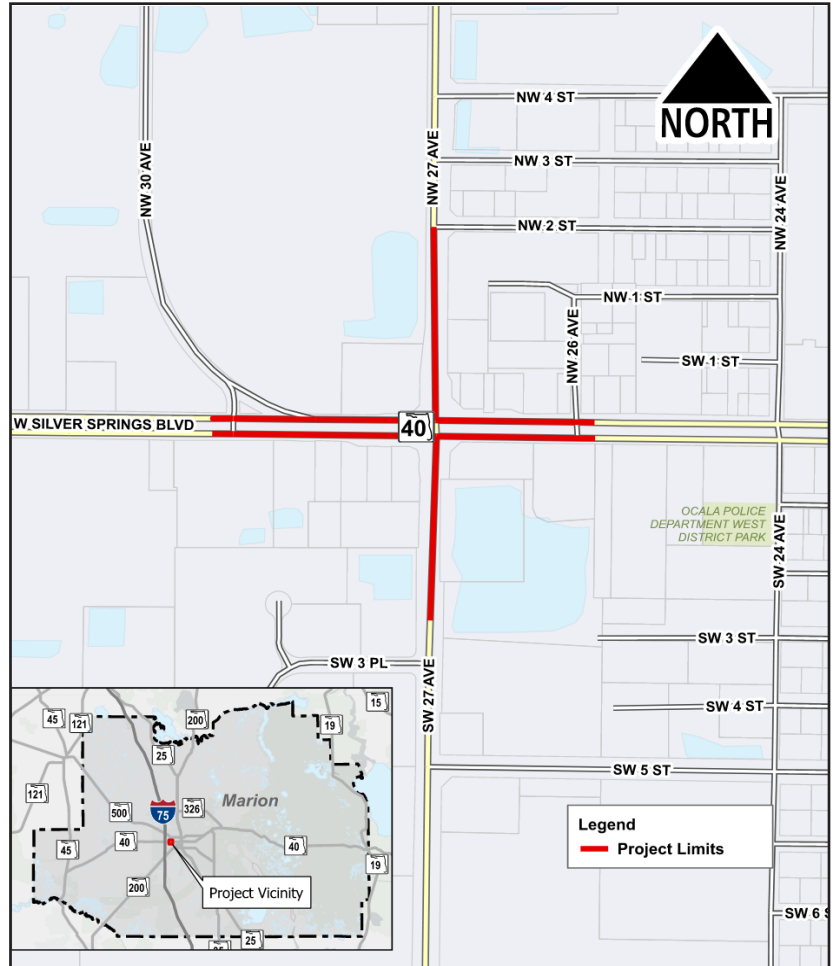
Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing safety and operational improvements to State Road (S.R.) 40 at the intersection of SW 27th Avenue in Ocala, Marion County.

Pedestrian safety improvements include reconstructing sidewalk curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, lighting upgrades, and refreshing crosswalks. Other proposed improvements include:

- Widening the S.R. 40 median to provide dual left-turn lanes at the eastbound and westbound intersection approaches.
- Widening to the outside on eastbound S.R. 40, approaching the intersection, to accommodate an exclusive right-turn lane.
- Reconstructing the SW 27th Avenue median to provide dual left-turn lanes at the northbound and southbound approaches.
- Reconfiguring the existing signal to accommodate lane improvements.

Additional improvements include roadway resurfacing, drainage improvements, and the removal or reconstruction of abandoned driveways.
