

U.S. 17 Multi-Use Trail

S.R. 40 to Washington Avenue & Palmetto Avenue to the Putnam County Line

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to construct a 12-foot-wide multi-use trail along the east (northbound) side of U.S. 17 (State Road (S.R.) 15) from S.R. 40 to the Putnam/Volusia County line.

The proposed trail will span 13.7 miles through the communities of Pierson and Seville. A 1-mile-long segment of the trail in Pierson was built in 2018.

The purpose of the project is to fill a gap in the 260-mile-long St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop (SJR2C) Trail.

The SJR2C Loop is a partially completed, paved path designed for walking, biking, and other non-motorized activities.

This project is part of the statewide goal of supporting the transportation and recreational needs of bicyclists and pedestrians. The State of Florida dedicates annual funding towards the continuing development of a statewide network of multi-use trails.
