Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting a corridor study for the segment of State Road (S.R.) 405 from north of S.R. 50 to east of U.S. 1, a distance of approximately 5.4 miles, within the City of Titusville and Brevard County. The purpose of the S.R. 405 Corridor Study is to determine the need for, and potential impacts of, widening the road from two to four lanes. The corridor study will consider surrounding land use, future growth, and potential impacts to the study area to determine the location and conceptual design of preferred roadway and mobility improvements.

Project Goals

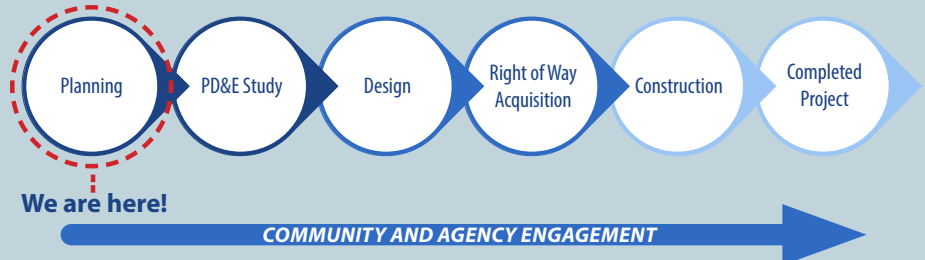


Proposed Improvements

The following proposed alternatives have been developed to the meet the project needs:

- **Safety and operational improvements** that can be designed and constructed in the **near-term** by identifying opportunities to fund spot improvements and incorporating them into other programmed projects.
- **Long-term widening** of S.R. 405 from 2 to 4-lanes that requires implementation through the project development process.
- A **combination** of near-term and long-term improvements.

Project Development Process



The S.R. 405 Corridor Planning Study is anticipated to be completed in fall 2025. Future phases are not funded at this time.
