





## **Corridor Issues**



Lack of turn lanes and signals between S.R. 50 and Fox Lake Road



Rear-end crashes



Unsafe bike and pedestrian behavior at eastern end of corridor



🔊 Left turn crashes



Trucks blocking traffic, straying outside intended lane



Some bus stops need improved waiting areas and pedestrian connections



Lack of protected left turn movements



New recycling facility
– anticipating more
truck traffic






#### **Alternative 2: Segmented Widening:**

2-4 lane widening from S.R. 50 to Fox Lake Rd




#### **Alternative 3: Full Widening:**
