



# State Road (S.R.) 40 Improvements

From U.S. 41 to SW 119<sup>th</sup> Avenue

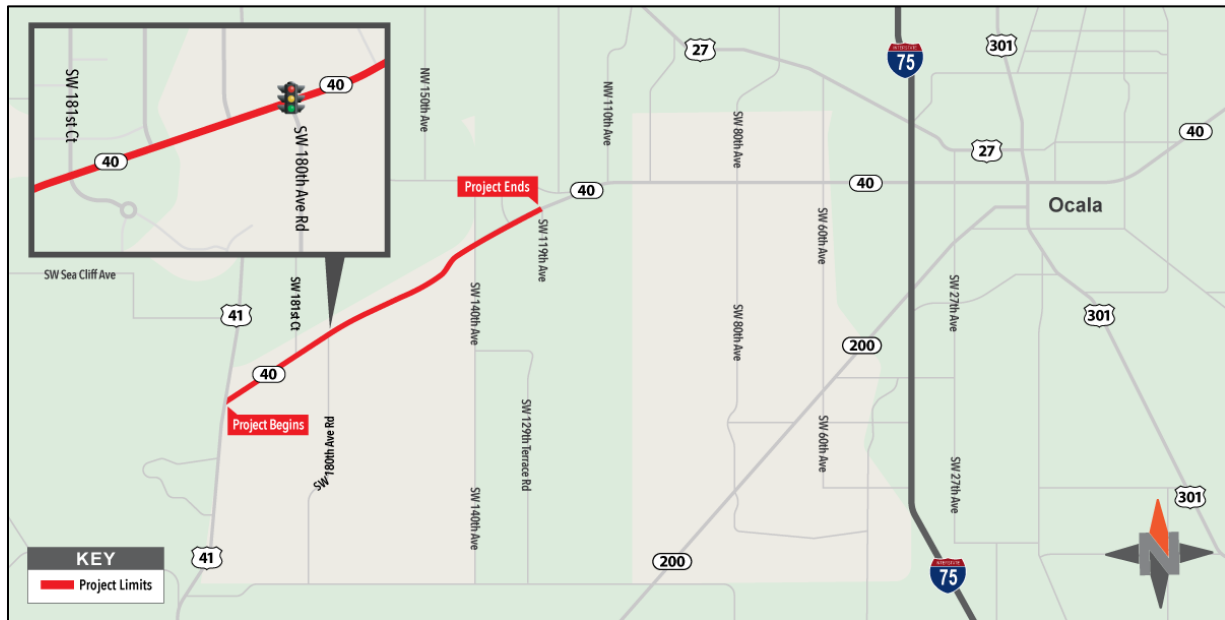
## Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements along State Road (S.R.) 40 from U.S. 41 to SW 119th Avenue, just west of Ocala in Marion County.

In addition to repaving the corridor, FDOT recently decided to expand the scope of work to include construction of a new traffic signal at the intersection of S.R. 40 and SW 180th Avenue Road. These improvements will help to enhance safety and maintain the roadway.

This project also includes approximately 0.6 miles of shoulder widening and a three-foot shift in roadway alignment just west of SW 133rd Avenue Road. This adjustment will reduce the angle of the curve to enhance safety and will be within the existing right of way.

Additionally, the project includes drainage and guardrail upgrades, as well as lighting improvements. A new crosswalk will be added on the east side of the SW 140th Avenue intersection, along with sidewalk connections at the intersection, and upgraded pedestrian signals. Pedestrian curb ramps will be reconstructed to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
