



S.R. 40 Maintenance Resurfacing

From U.S. 41 to south of SW 119th Avenue

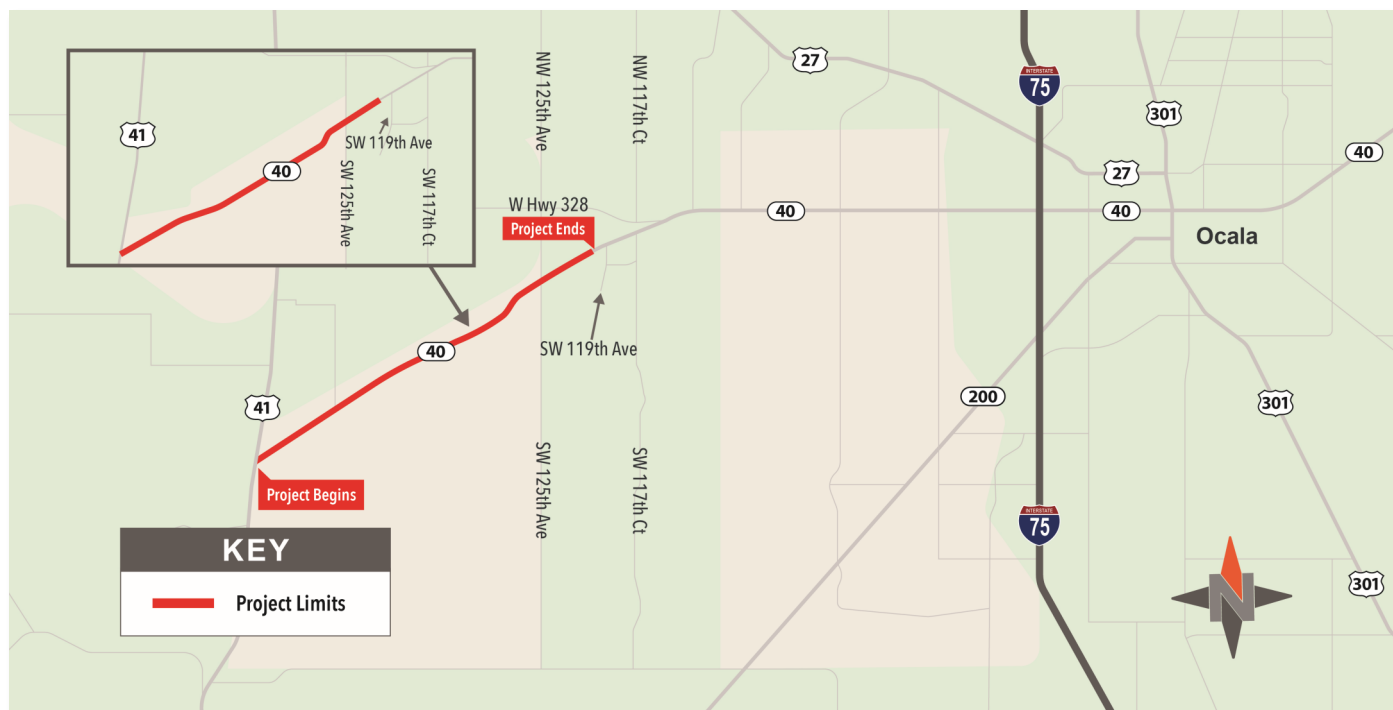


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to repave State Road (S.R.) 40 from U.S. 41 to south of SW 119th Avenue, located west of Ocala in Marion County. The purpose of this project is to maintain a safe and reliable asphalt surface.

In addition to resurfacing the roadway, this project includes approximately 0.6 miles of shoulder widening and shifting the roadway alignment by three feet just west of SW 133rd Avenue Road. This adjustment will reduce the angle of the curve to enhance safety and will be done within the existing right of way.

The project also includes drainage and guardrail upgrades, as well as lighting improvements. A new crosswalk will be added on the east side of the SW 140th Avenue intersection, along with sidewalk connections at the intersection, and upgraded pedestrian signals. Pedestrian curb ramps will be reconstructed to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
