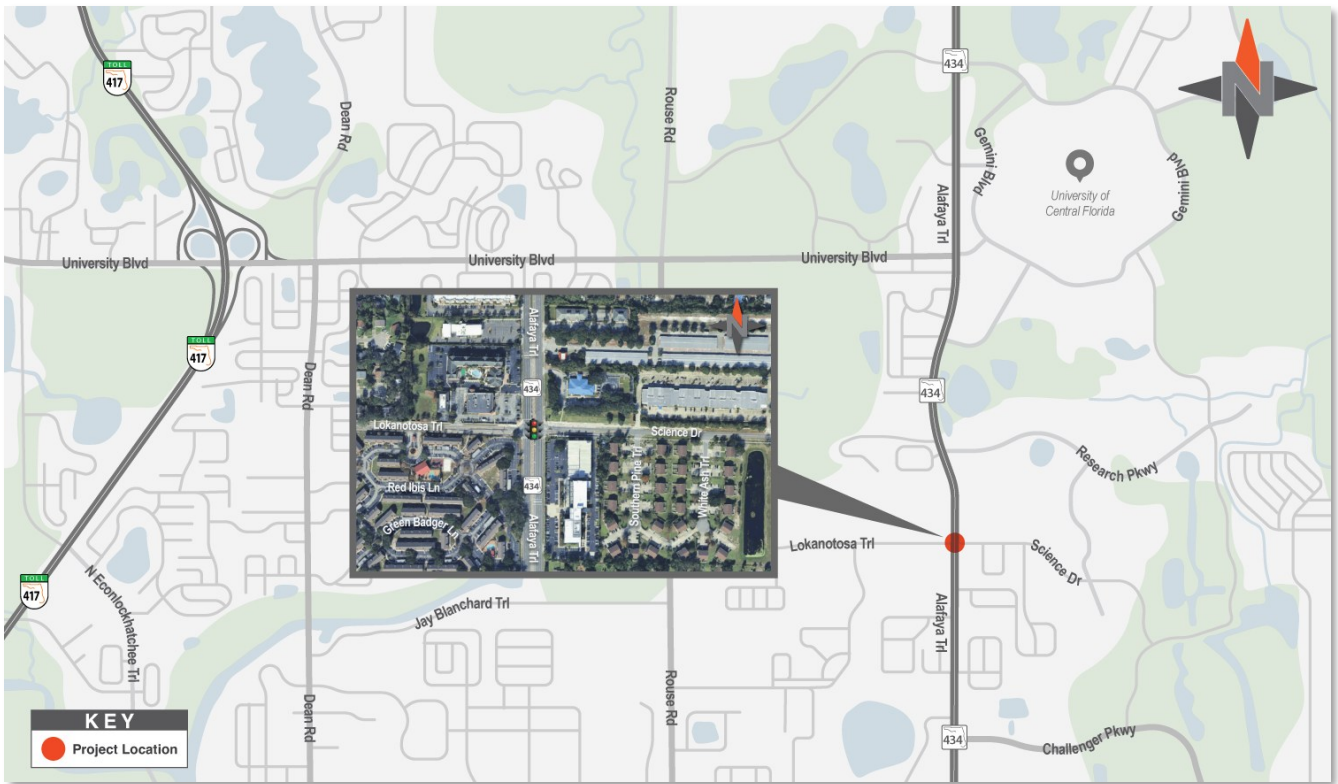

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements at the intersection of Alafaya Trail (State Road (S.R.) 434) and Lokanotosa Trail/Science Drive. The purpose of the project is to reconstruct and upgrade the existing traffic signal to improve operations and safety at the intersection.

The project plans to provide upgraded signal heads that align with each travel lane. A Leading Pedestrian Interval (LPI) will be added to allow people to begin crossing while all traffic is stopped. New pedestrian signals and intersection lighting will be installed. Crosswalks will be realigned and restriped. Additionally, pedestrian curb ramps will be upgraded to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
