


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to make improvements at the intersection of Kirkman Road (State Road (S.R.) 435) and Old Winter Garden Road (County Road (C.R.) 526) in Orlando. The purpose of the project is to enhance safety at the intersection.

The project includes reconstructing and upgrading the existing traffic signal to improve driver visibility. The project also includes repaving the intersection, updating signage and pavement markings, and upgrading curb ramps, as needed, to meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

The improvements are a result of an intersection safety study from 2022.
