### **State Road (S.R.) 401 Bridge Replacement Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study, Brevard County**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on the State Road (S.R.) 401 bridges from S.R. 528 to north of the Canaveral Barge Canal on Wednesday, February 23, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to evaluate the three existing S.R. 401 bridges over the Canaveral Barge Canal. Through this study, the FDOT will develop and analyze alternatives for rehabilitation or replacement of the bridges.
