

S.R. 520 (West King Street) Resurfacing From West of S.R. 524 to Tucker Lane

Brevard County





Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to resurface the segment of State Road (S.R.) 520 (West King Street) from west of S.R. 524 to east of Tucker Lane in the City of Cocoa. The purpose of this project is to replace the asphalt to maintain a safe and reliable driving surface and extend the service life of the roadway.

In addition, FDOT will evaluate and update existing curb ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, where necessary. The project will also install audible vibratory pavement markings along the shoulders within the project limits. This treatment enhances safety by alerting drivers if their vehicle drifts outside of the travel lane.
