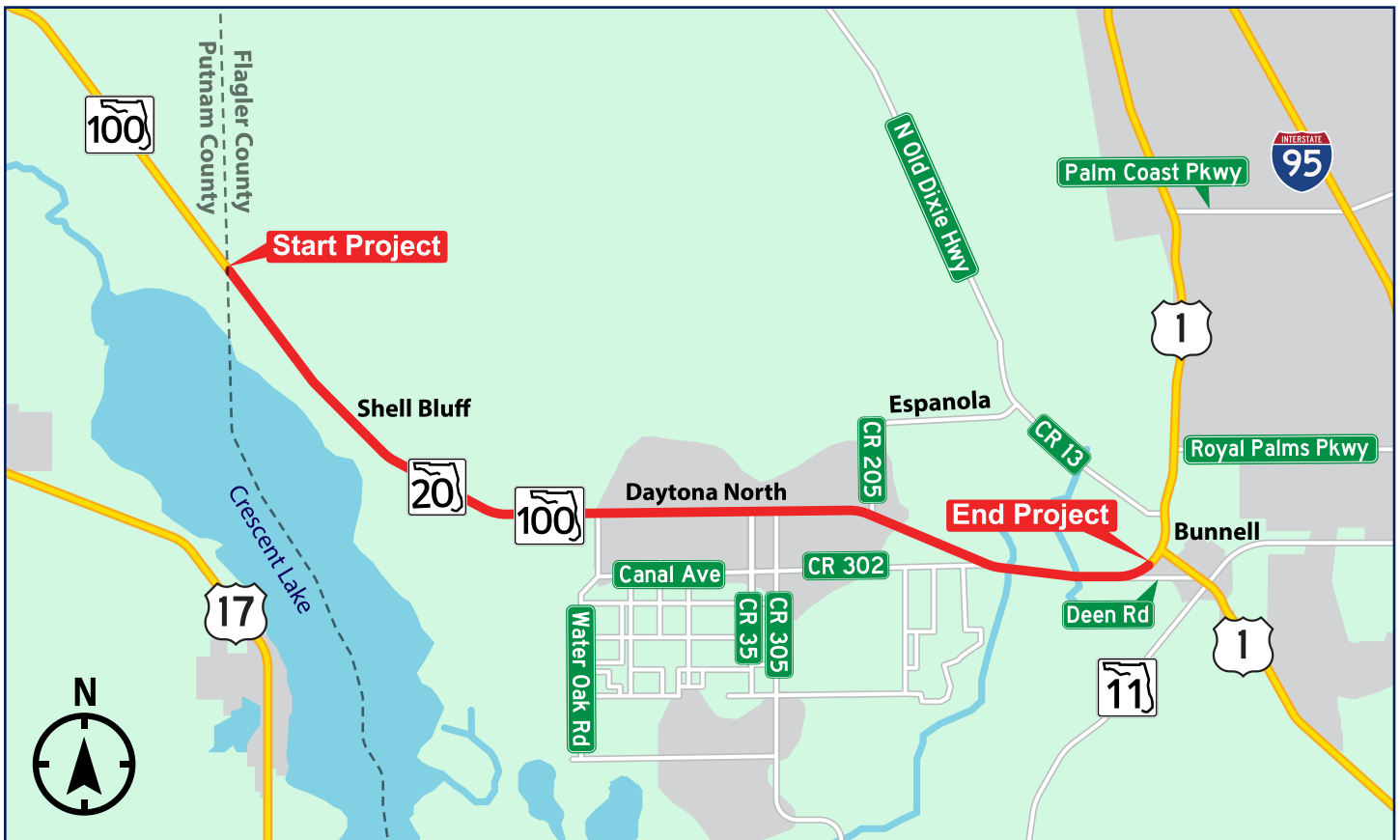
From the Putnam County Line to West of U.S. 1

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning roadway improvements on State Road (S.R.) 100 from the Putnam County line to west of U.S. 1 in Flagler County. The purpose of this project is to resurface the roadway and make operational improvements to enhance safety along the corridor.

Project Status & Cost*

Design:	Completion - fall 2026	\$ 2.5 Million

Construction:	Funded - spring 2027	\$ 16.3 Million

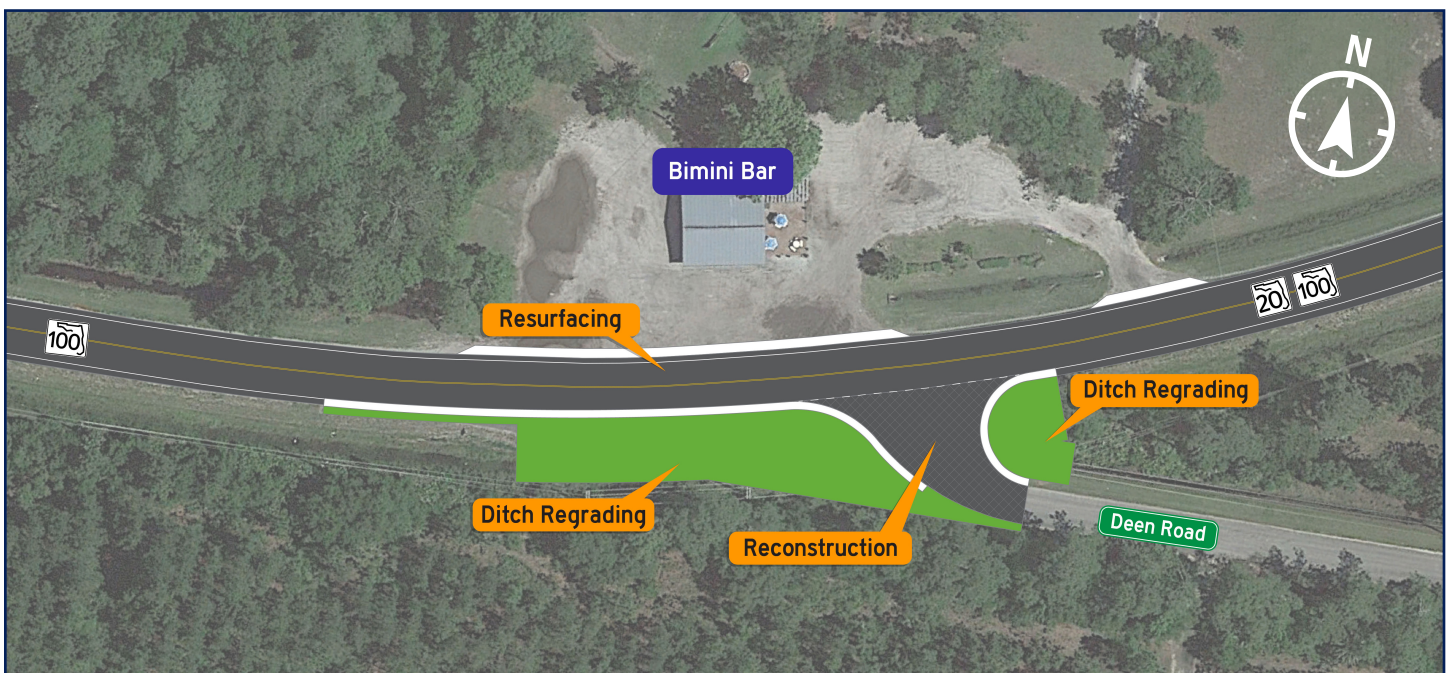


Figure 1: *Proposed Intersection Improvements at S.R. 100 and Deen Road.*

FDOT plans to improve the intersection of S.R. 100 and Deen Road by realigning the roadway connection to enhance sight distance and regrading the roadside ditches. (Figure 1) All improvements will occur within the existing right of way.

Other proposed improvements include:

- Evaluating existing guardrails to ensure they meet current safety standards. Guardrails will be reset or replaced where needed.
- Adding audible vibratory pavement markings along the shoulders and centerline to reduce lane departures and crossover crashes.
- Installing intersection lighting on S.R. 100 to improve visibility at the intersections of Water Oak Road, County Road (C.R.) 305, C.R. 302, and Deen Road.

The Department is also developing a separate project to improve drainage along the corridor just west of the U.S. 1 overpass. This effort is focused on addressing the drainage concerns in that area to enhance roadway resilience and reduce potential flooding impacts for motorists. Additional information about this future project will be provided as it advances through planning and design.
