

State Road (S.R. 50) Multi-Use Trail From Villa City Road to north of American Legion Road

Project Description


The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing plans for a new multi-use trail along State Road (S.R.) 50 from Villa City Road to north of American Legion Road in Lake County. The nearly 1.4mile trail would fill a gap in the Coastto-Coast Trail system within the cities of Mascotte and Groveland.

The proposed design adds a 10-to-12 -foot-wide multi-use path on the north side of S.R. 50. Additionally, midblock crossings with pedestrian signals are planned between Groveland Farms Road and Wendell Avenue, west of Atlantic Avenue, west of Alpine Street, and near American Legion Road.

Crosswalks will have marked pedestrian refuge areas in the median. The project also includes landscaping along the trail and in the medians. Additionally, sidewalk curb ramps will be upgraded to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Upon completion, the Coast-to-Coast Trail will span about 250 miles across Florida from St. Petersburg to Titusville. The trail is for pedestrians, bicyclists and other non-motorized vehicles.
