Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to resurface State Road (S.R.) 44 from west of Interstate 75 (I-75) to east of County Road (C.R.) 229. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the asphalt to extend the life of the roadway and maintain a safe and reliable driving surface.

In addition to repaving S.R. 44 along the corridor, the project will also fill in sidewalk gaps and reconstruct pedestrian curb ramps as needed to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. The project will also upgrade traffic signals and lighting along the corridor. Driveway openings will also be evaluated for possible reconstruction or modifications within existing FDOT right of way to enhance safety.
