

S. Pine Avenue Maintenance Resurfacing From SW 10th Street to SW 4th Street

Marion County






Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to repave South Pine Avenue (U.S. 27/U.S. 301/U.S. 441/State Road (S.R.) 25) from SW 10th Street (S.R. 200) to SW 4th Street in Ocala. The purpose of this project is to maintain a safe and reliable asphalt surface.

In addition to resurfacing, this project includes upgrading pedestrian curb ramps, as needed, to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Other improvements include updated pedestrian signals, signage, and pavement markings.
