PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is making improvements to the State Road (S.R.) 44 (South Causeway) bridge that crosses the Indian River in New Smyrna Beach. Planned work includes replacing bearing pads and expansion joints under the bridge, to extend its lifespan.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect intermittent single-lane closures to accommodate work activities. Eastbound lane closures may occur between 8:30 p.m. and 7:30 a.m., while westbound lane closures may occur from 5 p.m. until 1 p.m. the following day.

The existing posted speed limit of 45 mph will stay in effect, and sidewalks will remain open during construction. The fishing pier will remain open throughout construction however, parking may be limited at certain times. To maintain safety throughout the project, FDOT encourages visitors not to enter the work zone at any time.

Electronic message boards and other signage will direct traffic through the work zone. The level of work activity and noise will vary during different construction phases. Please note that the construction schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances. 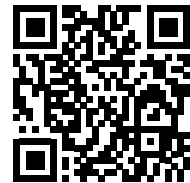
