The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is holding a public meeting regarding improvements to State Road (SR) 50. The purpose of this meeting is to introduce the project and present the preliminary design concepts to the public. The meeting is an open house beginning at 5:30 p.m. Staff members will be available to discuss the project and answer questions. A brief looping presentation and other project information will be available throughout the evening. The meeting ends at 7:30 p.m.

PROJECT FACTS

- The roadway will be widened from a four-lane urban other principal arterial to a six-lane other principal arterial.
- A full median access management analysis will be required as part of the project.
- Sidewalks and bicycle lanes will be provided on both sides of the roadway.
- Drainage will be accommodated by stormwater ponds.
- The design phase for this project is anticipated to be completed within 24 months.
