I. OVERVIEW:

The purpose of this public meeting was to present the PD&E study for the widening of U.S. 17-92 to the public, share the results of the existing and future conditions assessment, and explain the alternatives developed for the project corridor in order to receive public feedback. FDOT offered three ways to participate in the meeting; in-person option, virtual option (online), and phone option (listen only). All participants received the same information regardless of method attended. The meeting was held on Tuesday, October 12, 2021.

II. PUBLIC NOTICE:

The meeting was advertised in advance through several methods including:

- Notification emails to approximately 158 state and local elected officials, appointed public officials, and other agencies sent on September 13, 2021.
- Direct mail notifications to approximately 741 property owners sent in English and Spanish on September 17, 2021.
- Display newspaper advertisement in the Osceola Sentinel on September 30, 2021 and in El Osceola Star on October 1, 2021.
- Florida Administrative Register advertisement in Volume 47, Number 191 Edition on October 1, 2021.
- Press release from FDOT communications on October 4, 2021.
- Meeting information posted to project website.

III. FORMAT:

The meeting was conducted in two formats. The in-person format was conducted as an

open house setting beginning at 5:30 p.m. Attendees could view project displays, view a looping narrated presentation, and ask questions with available project staff. Attendees were given a comment form to submit written comments about the project. The open house ended at 7:30 p.m.

For the virtual format, a GoToWebinar began at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 12, 2021. During the virtual meeting, the narrated presentation (shown during the in-person meeting) was played. Attendees were encouraged to submit their comments and questions via the online meeting's chat-box throughout the presentation and were given an additional 10 minutes following the presentation video. Attendees were also given links to download the project displays and comment forms. All materials presented at the virtual format were the same as offered at the in-person location. A phone-in line was provided for those who wanted to join the virtual format but did not have access to a computer, tablet, or smart phone. Persons choosing the phone-in option were encouraged to contact the project manager to submit comments or ask questions.

All meeting materials, including the video presentation, project displays, and comment form were posted on the project website on Monday, October 11, 2021.

IV. ATTENDANCE

Approximately 34 members of the public attended the in-person meeting. Sixteen members of the public attended the virtual GoToWebinar. Additionally, four FDOT staff members, four staff representing the Poinciana Parkway Extension and CR 532 widening projects, and seven members of the consultant study team attended the meeting (total of 65 participants). 
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FDOT is currently evaluating alternatives to widen U.S. 17-92 from the current twolane roadway to a four-lane divided roadway, from Ivy Mist Lane to Avenue A, in Osceola County.

This project is located between two ongoing projects. The project west of Ivy Mist Lane is the Poinciana Parkway Extension being completed by Central Florida Expressway Authority or CFX. The Poinciana Parkway Extension, currently in design and planned to go to construction in 2022, will include a diverging diamond interchange with US 17-92 just southwest of Ivy Mist Lane.


The project east of Avenue A is the US 17-92 widening project which is widening from 2 to 4 lanes from Avenue A to Ham Brown Road. The US 17-92 widening project is currently under construction and anticipated to be completed in Spring of 2022. Also adjacent to this project is the County Road 532 widening from Old Lake Wilson Road to US 17-92. The County Road 532 widening project is currently in design and anticipated to be completed by summer of 2022.



A Project Development and Environment Study or PD&E study determines the location and conceptual design of the preferred roadway improvements and the associated social, economic, and environmental effects of the improvement.

A PD&E Study has three main components; an engineering analysis which includes defining and evaluating alternatives (including a no-build alternative), environmental evaluations which evaluate potential impacts to the social, cultural and physical environments and a public involvement component to inform and involve all interested parties in the development of the planned transportation project and to seek public input.

This process is mandated by the National Environmental Policy Act (or NEPA "neepa") and Florida law. It represents a combined effort by technical professionals who analyze information and document the best alternative for a community's transportation needs.



The Project Development process consists of five steps, including long-range planning toidentify the project need, PD&E study, project design, right of way acquisition and construction.

The PD&E study is the second phase of the Project Development process where an engineering and environmentally feasible alternative that meets the community's transportation needs is determined. The location and conceptual design of improvements are identified, and environmental and social impacts are assessed.



Purpose and Need

The purpose of this project is to satisfy future travel demand needs and improve safety conditions for this regionally significant arterial roadway.




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The purpose of this project is to satisfy future travel demand needs and improve safety conditions for this regionally significant arterial roadway. The need for the project is based on projected traffic expected to exceed capacity for the existing two-lane roadway and the current lack of pedestrian and bicycle accommodations along the entire study corridor.

This project is consistent with Osceola County's Comprehensive Plan to provide a multimodal facility by 2040 and is included in MetroPlan Orlando's State Highway System list as priority #4.




The maximum volume a two-lane roadway can service is 18,585 vehicles per day. Both the existing traffic, with 28,000 average vehicles per day and the no build 2045 projected 37,500 average vehicles per day along US 17/92 exceed the two-lane roadway max service volume.



This project is considering widening U.S. 17-92 from two to four lanes from Ivy Mist Lane to Avenue A. There are several alternatives that are identified for this project. However, the proposed typical sections will be consistent between all alternatives. The difference in alternatives is within the alignment of the roadway. Therefore, these alternatives will be called Alignment Alternatives. The Alignment Alternatives will be identified in two segments.

The western segment from Ivy Mist Lane to just east of the Muslim Cemetery of Central Florida consists of several connections and constraints including a connection to the Poinciana Parkway Extension, a connection to County Road 532, a new and existing bridge over Reedy Creek, avoidance of Fletcher Park, a connection to Old Tampa Highway and avoidance of the Muslim Cemetery of Central Florida. Due to these constraints and connections only one alignment will be evaluated which will consist of the best fit alignment to minimize impacts along the western segment.


The eastern segment from just east of the Muslim Cemetery of Central Florida to Avenue A will provide three alignment alternatives. Each alternative alignment shifts the widening to the north, south or centered along the existing roadway. The detailed concept layouts for each alignment alternative are shown on the public meetings displays and are available on the project website.




There are four typical sections that will be applied along the study corridor. Each of the typical sections and their segments are common among the three alignment alternatives.

Typical section 1 consists of two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, with flush outside and inside shoulders, and divided by a raised 22-foot median. A 12-foot shared use path will be provided along the north side of the roadway and a 6-foot sidewalk will be provided on the south. In this typical section, the roadside ditches are between the roadway and sidewalk or shared use path, to provide separation from the roadway traffic. The total right of way required for this typical section is 230-feet wide.


Typical section 1 applies to the study corridor from Ivy Mist Lane to the Reedy Creek Bridge, from Old Tampa Highway to Intercession City, and from Intercession City to Avenue A. It will have a speed limit of 55 mph.



Typical section 2 applies to the study corridor along the Reedy Creek Bridge. For this section, the existing Reedy Creek Bridge will be restriped to provide two 12-foot travel lanes for the eastbound traffic. A new bridge will be constructed north of the existing bridge to provide two 12-foot travel lanes for the westbound traffic and will include a 12-foot shared use path separated from the roadway traffic by a physical barrier. The width of the new Reedy Creek bridge will be approximately 56-feet wide. The speed limit for this typical section will be 55 mph.




Typical section 3 applies to the study corridor between Reedy Creek Bridge and Old Tampa Highway and consists of two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, with 4-foot inside paved shoulders and 7-foot outside paved shoulders. The roadway will include curb and gutter and a 22-foot raised median. A 12-foot shared use path will be provided along the north side of the roadway and a 6-foot sidewalk along the south side. The total right of way required for this typical section is approximately 195-feet wide. The speed limit for this typical section will be 55 mph. This smaller section will help minimize impacts to homes and environmentally sensitive areas, as well as facilitate the new alignment of Old Tampa Highway into US 17-92.




Typical section 4 applies to study corridor within Intercession City and consists of two 11-foot travel lanes in each direction with curb and gutter and a 22-foot raised median. A 12-foot shared use path will be provided along the north side of the roadway and a 6-foot sidewalk along the south side. The total right of way for this typical section is approximately 112-feet wide. The speed limit for this typical section will be 35 mph.



As part of this project, community enhancements within Intercession City are being considered that provide protected pedestrian crossings and speed management practices. Potential pedestrian crossing treatments include the use of a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon, also known as RRFB, or the use of a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon, also known as PHB. Potential improvements that encourage speed management include narrower travel lanes, landscaping, speed feedback signs, and speed limit pavement markings. These strategies will be considered as the project moves forward.



We're evaluating several improvement alternatives for the intersections of Osceola Polk Line Road, Old Tampa Highway, and Avenue A. Intersection concepts include signalization, roundabouts and other alternatives. Additional information regarding the various intersection concepts being considered are provided on the public meeting displays and are available on the project website.



Four drainage basins have been identified for the corridor. Drainage ponds are needed to accommodate and treat additional stormwater runoff. Several pond locations are being considered; however, only one pond will be selected for each drainage basin.

Floodplain compensation areas are also being considered to mitigate floodplain impacts anticipated from the project.

An offsite compensation area is also being evaluated on the southeast side of Intercession City

Coordination with adjacent projects is ongoing to determine the potential for joint use pond locations.



Environmental features are also being evaluated to determine if the roadway widening results in significant impacts to the natural, social, cultural, or physical environments.



These design concepts (along with the "no build" alternative) were evaluated and the results are shown in the evaluation matrix. There are many similarities between the three alternatives. The primary differences are within the potential right of way impacts and associated right of way acquisition costs.


The number of parcels potentially impacted is highest for Alternative 1 with 106 parcels, compared with Alternatives 2 and 3, with 80 and 79 parcels, respectively. Additionally, the number of potential relocations is highest for Alternative 1 with a potential for 36 relocations, compared with 24 potential relocations for Alternative 2, and 27 potential relocations for Alternative 3.

The estimated right of way cost for is 92.2 million for Alternative 1, 80.1 million for Alternative 2, and 82 million for Alternative 3.




We began this PD&E study in July of 2020 and we expect it to be completed in the summer of 2023. The public hearing is anticipated to be held early spring of 2023.

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




