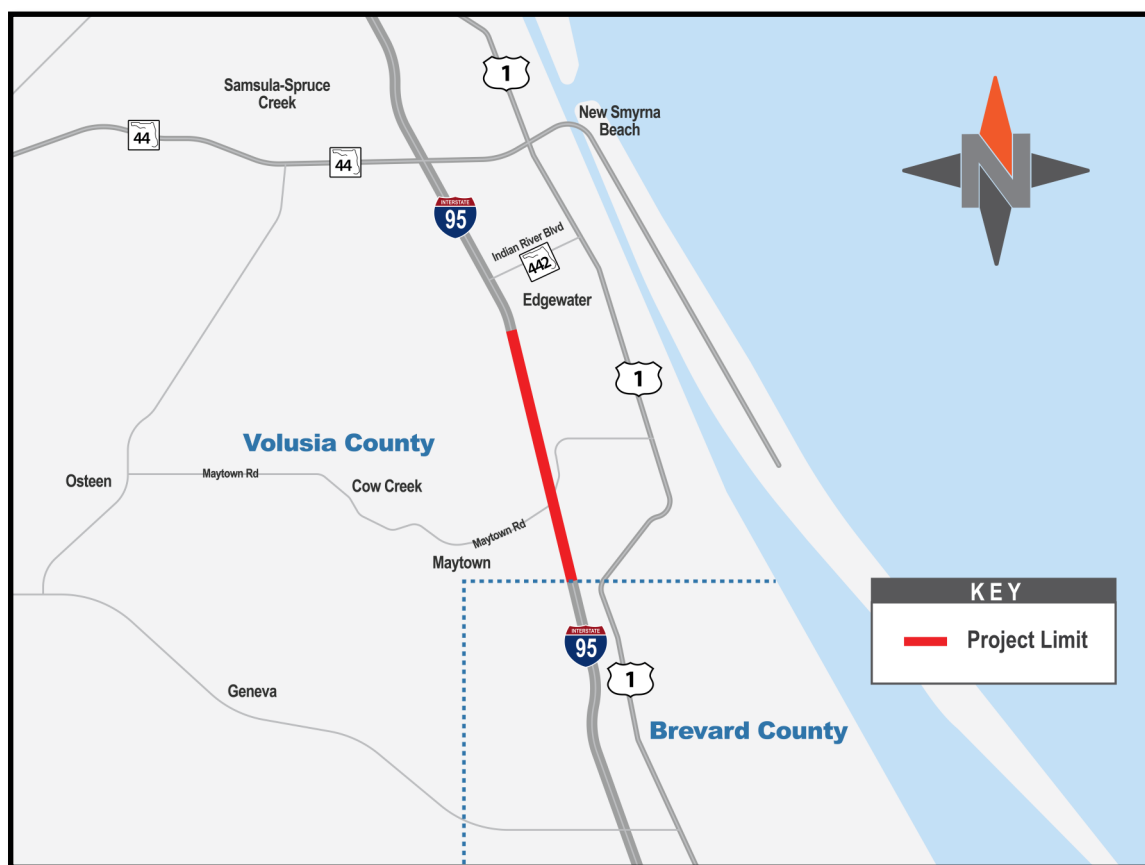

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to resurface Interstate 95 (I-95) from the Brevard County line to south of State Road (S.R.) 442 (Indian River Boulevard) in Volusia County. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the asphalt pavement and maintain a safe and reliable driving surface.

In addition to repaving all travel lanes, the project will resurface the shoulders and upgrade pavement markings and signage. Bridge deck repairs will also be made to the bridges over Maytown Road.
