


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning improvements to enhance safety, increase capacity, and provide multi-modal accommodations along State Road (S.R.) 40 from the end of the four-lane section, just east of NE 58th Avenue, to east of County Road (C.R.) 314 east of Ocala.

The project plans to widen the existing two-lane undivided roadway to create four-lane divided roadway along this 5.3-mile segment. The proposed typical section includes two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction separated by a 40-foot-wide grassed median. A 12-foot-wide multi-use trail is planned along the north side of the road from NE 60th Court to Ray Wayside Park near the Ocklawaha River Bridge where it crosses to the South and continues to the end of the project.

This project also includes the replacement of the existing single Ocklawaha River Bridge with two bridges at a lower profile. Wildlife crossings are proposed throughout the project. Additional improvements include the drainage system and signalization.
