



Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing safety improvements at the intersection of State Road (S.R.) 200 and SW 62nd Avenue/SW 73rd Street Road in Ocala. The purpose of these improvements is to enhance the safety and efficiency of this intersection by improving traffic flow and reducing conflict points, or locations where a crash can occur.

Proposed improvements include converting the existing full median opening to a two-way directional median opening and extending the median nose for the westbound approach. These proposed improvements will allow U-turns and left turns for vehicles traveling eastbound and westbound along S.R. 200. Left turns from SW 62nd Avenue and SW 73rd Street Road will be prohibited.

Signing and pavement markings will also be updated.
