PROJECT DESCRIPTION


The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is restoring bridge slopes that were damaged by Hurricane Milton, bringing them back to their original elevation. Work includes replacing protection materials such as embankment bedding stone, riprap (large stones or broken concrete), filter fabric, flowable fill, concrete sidewalk and sod. The project will also install temporary floating barriers to keep soil and debris from washing into the water.

The bridges along State Road (S.R.) 528, S.R. 404, S.R. 520, and U.S. 192 in Brevard County will be repaired.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect intermittent daytime and nighttime single lane closures between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m., with times varying at each location.

Electronic message boards and other signage will direct traffic through the work zone. The level of work activity and noise will vary during different construction phases. Please note that the construction schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
