



John Young Parkway (U.S. 17-92) at Pleasant Hill Quadrant Road

Project Description

The purpose of this project is to alleviate congestion at the John Young Parkway (U.S. 17-92) and Pleasant Hill Road intersection by providing an alternate route for westbound John Young Parkway traffic headed to southbound Pleasant Hill Road, and northbound Pleasant Hill Road traffic heading to eastbound John Young Parkway.

The project calls for constructing a new quadrant road to connect the Fern Drive at Pleasant Hill Road intersection with the existing Oaks Boulevard opening on John Young Parkway. Other improvements include realigning Oaks Boulevard to the west with a signalized connection to the quadrant road, and adding new traffic signals at Pleasant Hill Road and Fern Drive, and on John Young Parkway at the new quadrant road.
