

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to repave North Semoran Boulevard (State Road (S.R.) 436) from north of Banchory Road to the Seminole County line (north of Bishop Park Drive) in Orange County. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the asphalt and maintain a safe and reliable driving surface.

In addition to resurfacing the roadway, the project also includes upgrading curb ramps, as needed, to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
