

Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) State Road (S.R.) 482/Sand Lake Road Widening Project

Financial IDs: 407143-4-52-01, 407143-5-52-01, 407143-6-52-01

Overall Project Description

This four-mile construction project will reconstruct and widen S.R. 482/Sand Lake Road from four to six lanes. It also includes milling and resurfacing; bridge widening of the S.R. 435/Kirkman Road overpass; sidewalks; new storm drainage systems; utility relocation; demolition and reconstruction of the bridge over Shingle Creek; median modifications; traffic signals; and the construction of a new "flyover" bridge for John Young Parkway over Sand Lake Road. The goal is to alleviate traffic and improve safety for motorists and pedestrians.

Sand Lake Road from West of International Drive (I-Drive) to Universal Boulevard and I-Drive from Jamaican Court to North of Sand Lake Road

This segment includes widening and reconstruction, milling and resurfacing, signing, pavement markings, traffic signals, concrete sidewalks, median access modifications, the installation of sheet pile retaining walls, a new storm water drainage system, new water and sanitary force main, utility upgrades and the placement of some electrical utilities underground.

I-Drive Construction Highlights

- Addition of bus lane and right turn lane on north International Drive between Jamaican Court and Sand Lake Road
- Widening and extension of right turn lane on International Drive southbound to westbound Sand Lake Road
- New sanitary force main and lift station
- Widening of Sand Lake Road from International Drive to Universal Boulevard to create three eastbound and three westbound thru lanes
- New water main along Sand Lake Road
- Addition of raised concrete medians and directional turns

What to Expect

Nighttime lane closures will occur during construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert the public to any changes in the traffic pattern. In addition, pedestrians may have to alter their routes as portions of existing sidewalk may be temporarily closed. Signage and barricades will help safely direct pedestrians around work zones.
