

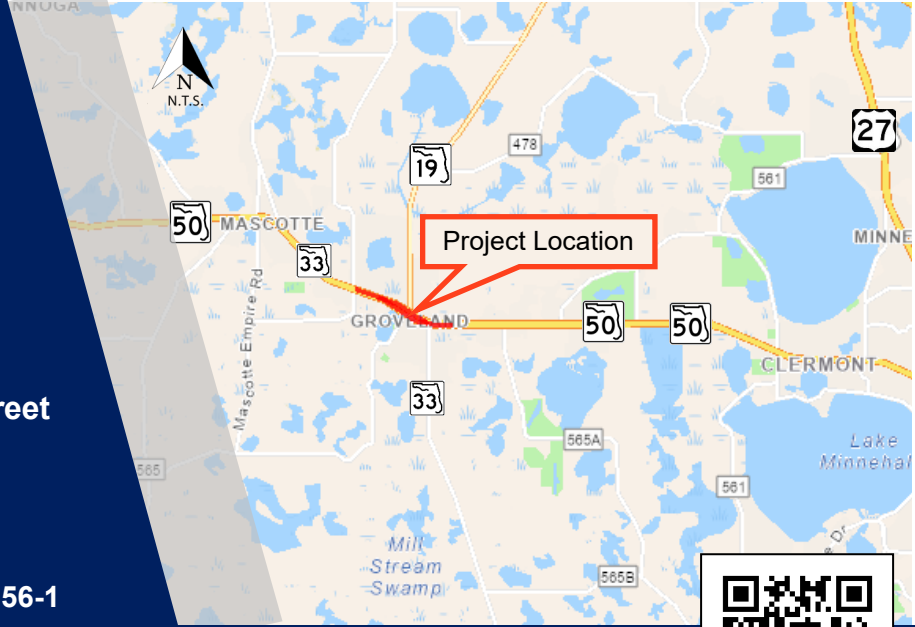


S.R. 50 Realignment

From Villa City Road (C.R. 565) to Brown Street

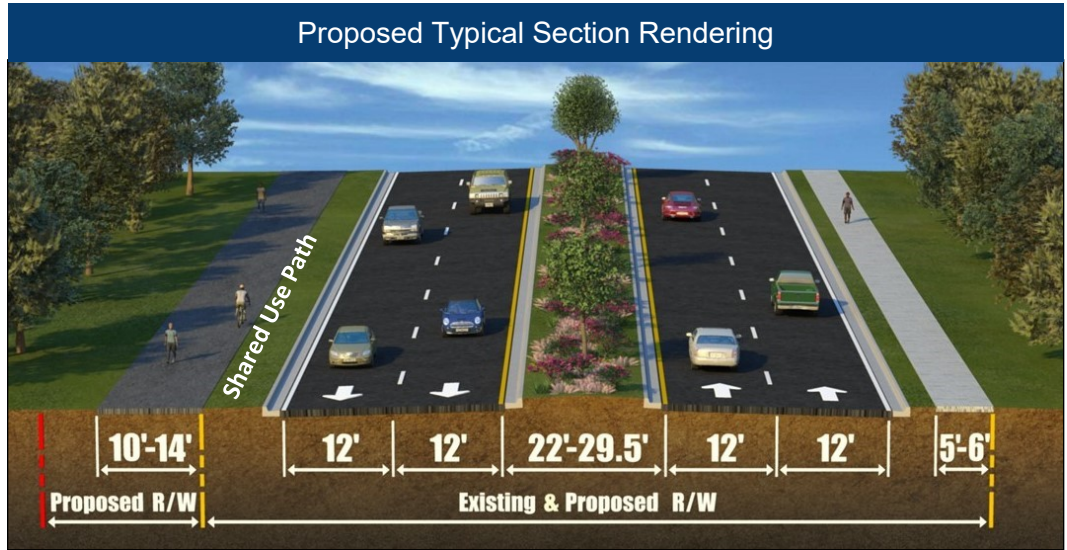

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) proposes operational and safety improvements along State Road (S.R.) 50 from Villa City Road (County Road (C.R.) 565) to Brown Street. In Groveland. Currently, S.R. 50 consists of a one-way pair through the downtown, with westbound traffic on Broad Street and eastbound traffic on Orange Street.

The purpose of this project is to realign S.R. 50 just north of downtown Groveland. The realigned road will help to remove a significant amount of heavy truck traffic from the downtown area. The realignment is desired by the City of Groveland to enhance livability and walkability and to help reduce truck traffic in the downtown area. Once the realignment is in place, Broad and Orange Streets will become city streets.



The project is currently in a design update phase. In addition to realigning S.R. 50, the project proposes to close the gap in the South Lake Trail (a regional network and part of the Coast to Coast Trail), by constructing a new shared-use path. Intersection improvements at S.R. 19 and S.R. 33 are also planned.
