From the Polk County Line to West of C.R. 33

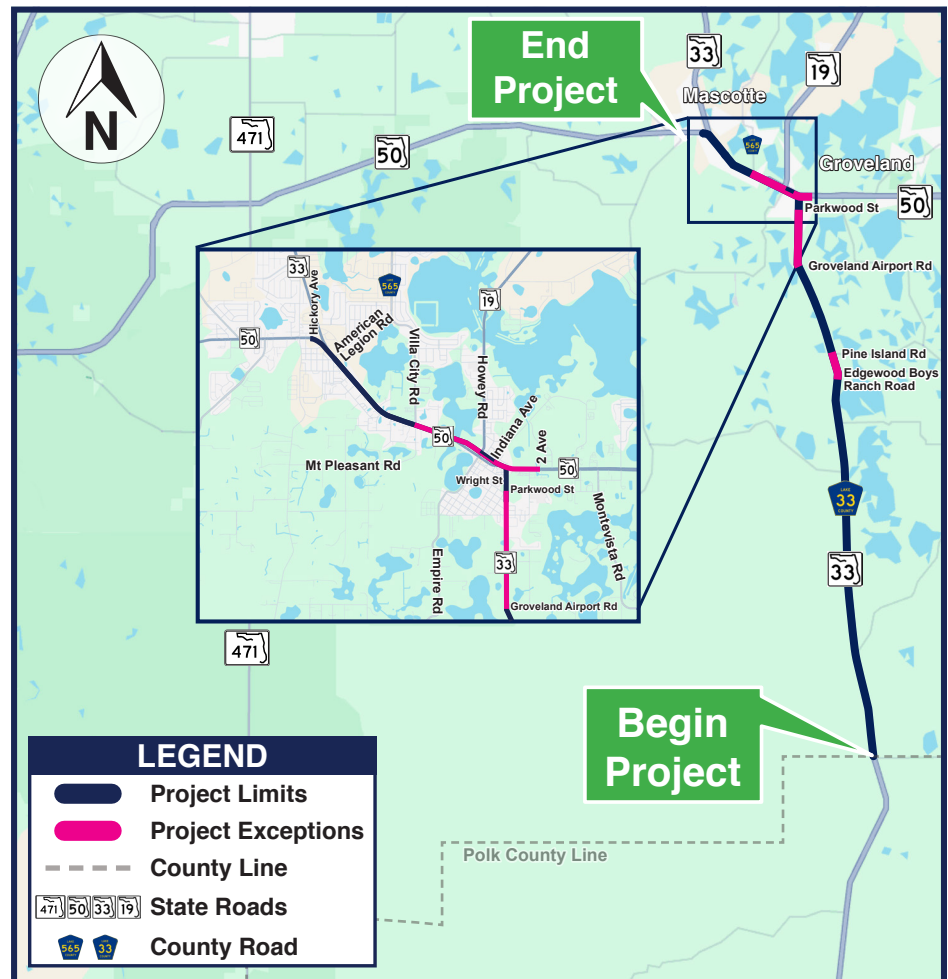
Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to resurface a segment of State Road (S.R.) 33 from the Polk County line to west of County Road (C.R.) 33 in Mascotte and Groveland. At the northern end of the project, S.R. 33 is also S.R. 50. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the asphalt and maintain a safe and reliable roadway surface.

In addition to repaving the roadway, the project will refresh striping and pavement markings, upgrade some signs as needed, and reconstruct pedestrian curb ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Audible and vibratory treatments will be used to enhance safety where the posted speed is 50 mph or greater.

This project overlaps with other projects in the area; work within the limits of those projects is not included. The projects include:

- **FPID No. 445685-1:** S.R. 33 (C.R. 33) from south of Edgewood Boys Ranch Road to Wright Street
- **FPID No. 427056-1:** S.R. 50/ S.R. 33 from C.R. 565 (Villa City Road) to 2nd Avenue
- **FPID No. 452915-1:** S.R. 50/ S.R. 33 from C.R. 565 to north of American Legion Road
