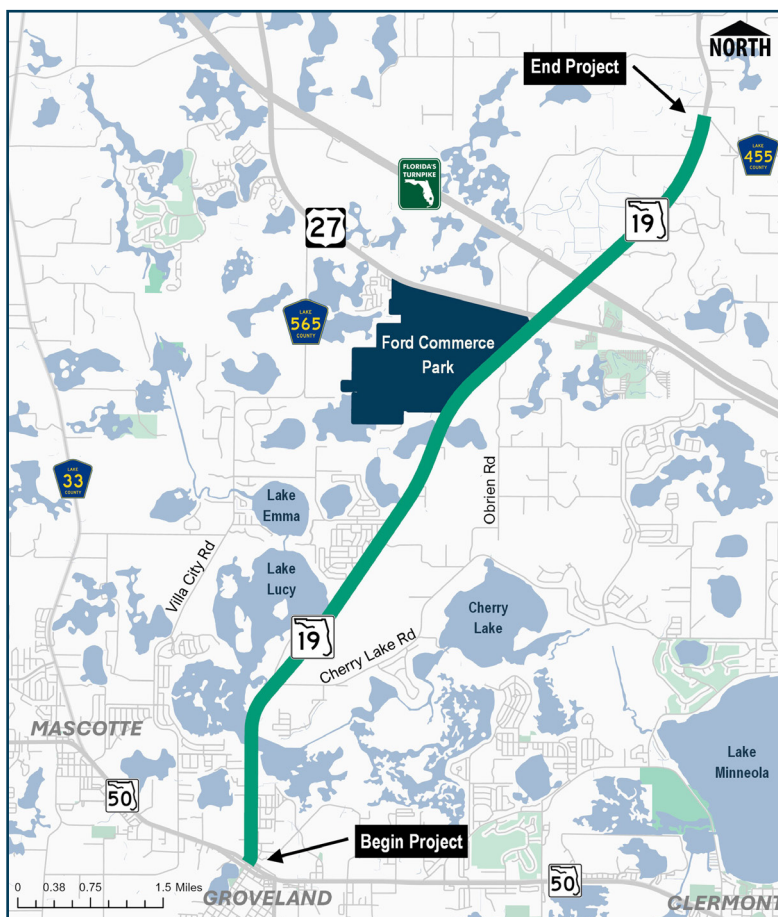


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting a Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study along State Road (S.R.) 19 in Lake County, Central Florida, from S.R. 50 to County Road (C.R.) 455. The study corridor is approximately 9.4 miles. The purpose of this effort is to evaluate current and future transportation needs and identify potential improvement strategies to enhance safety and better accommodate future growth and travel demand within the corridor.

The corridor has experienced both commercial and residential growth in recent years, including industrial development such as the Ford Commerce Park.

As part of this effort, the project will evaluate widening of S.R. 19 from two lanes to four lanes and assess the potential impacts and enhancements to the natural, social, cultural, and physical environments associated with these improvements.
