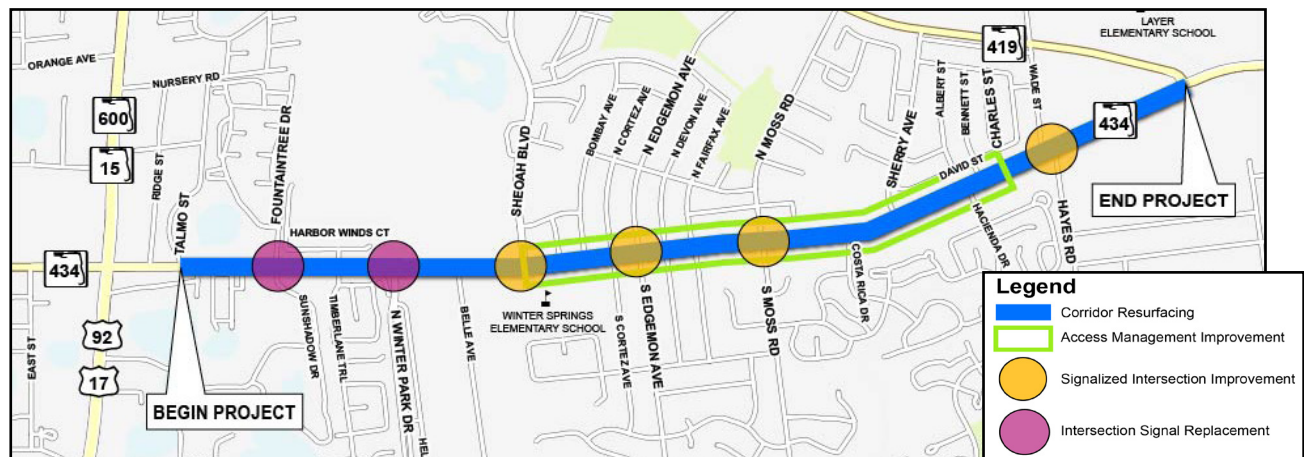
Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements to State Road (S.R.) 434 from east of U.S. 17-92 (S.R. 15/600) to S.R. 419 in Seminole County, a distance of approximately 2.09 miles. The project is within the cities of Casselberry, Longwood, and Winter Springs.

The purpose of this project is to enhance safety and operations along the corridor, as well as provide a rehabilitated asphalt surface to maintain the roadway. In addition to repaving S.R. 434, the project will replace a portion of the two-way center turn lane with a raised median and directional openings between Sheoah Boulevard and Charles Street. Full median openings are placed at Sherry Avenue and Hacienda Drive, while directional median openings are proposed at Bombay Avenue, Fairfax Avenue, and Costa Rica Drive.

Pedestrian safety improvements include reconstructing sidewalk curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, restore pedestrian railing at the Sheoah Boulevard intersection, and refresh all crosswalks.

The existing signals at Fountaintree Drive/Sunshadow Drive and at Winter Park Drive will be reconstructed and upgraded. Signal enhancements are also planned at other existing signals along the corridor.
