



I-95 Resurfacing

From the Southbound Rest Area to the Volusia County line
Brevard County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to mill and resurface Interstate 95 (I-95) / State Road (S.R.) 9 from the southbound rest area to the Volusia County line in Brevard County. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the asphalt pavement to maintain a safe and reliable driving surface.

In addition to resurfacing, the project will upgrade guardrail where needed, install new signage, repair slabs and joints on the bridges, and conduct minor drainage work. The work also includes wrong-way driver countermeasures.

Some overnight detours will be needed for a few nights during construction. Drivers will be alerted by electronic message signs along I-95.
