

INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

South Pine Avenue (U.S. 441/U.S. 27/U.S. 301) between SW 3rd Street to NW 2nd Street

Marion County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will construct intersection improvements on South Pine Avenue (U.S. 441/U.S. 27/U.S. 301) between SW 3rd Street and NW 2nd Street to enhance safety and operations for drivers and pedestrians.

This project includes the milling and resurfacing of existing travel lanes, widening turn lanes, and upgrading traffic signals. Additional work consists of drainage improvements, pavement markings and sidewalk modifications that comply with current Americans with Disabilities (ADA) standards.

The proposed improvements will add a dual left turn on northbound U.S. 441 to State Road (S.R.) 40 and extend the left turn lane from southbound U.S. 441 to S.R. 40, and the northbound left turn from U.S. 441 to NW 2nd Street.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect lane closures and detours on weekdays and weekends. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic through the work zone.

Uneven pavement is a common condition with projects that require temporary asphalt pavement or resurfacing, as the contractor must put down different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone.

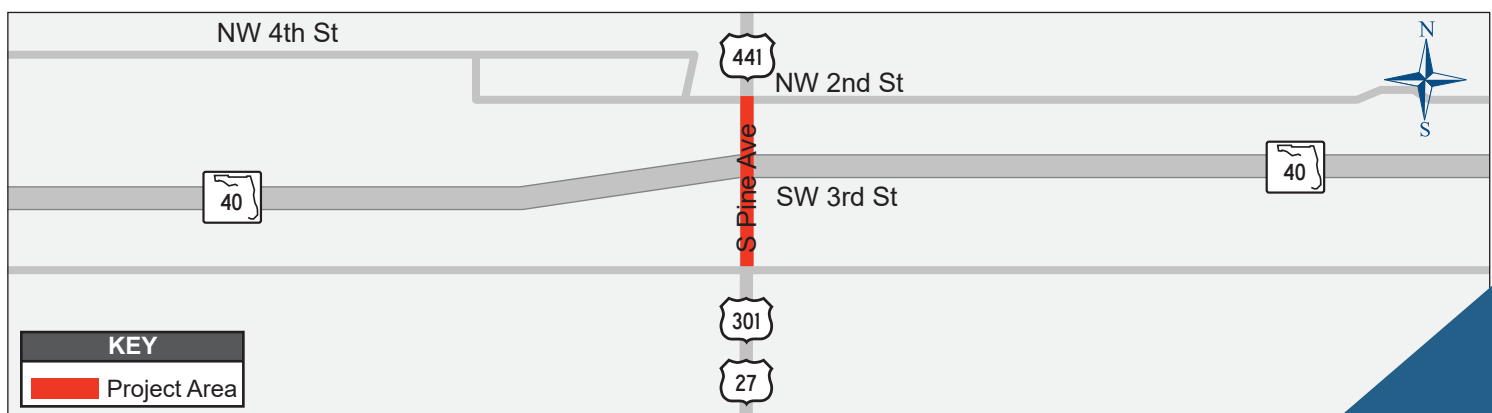
