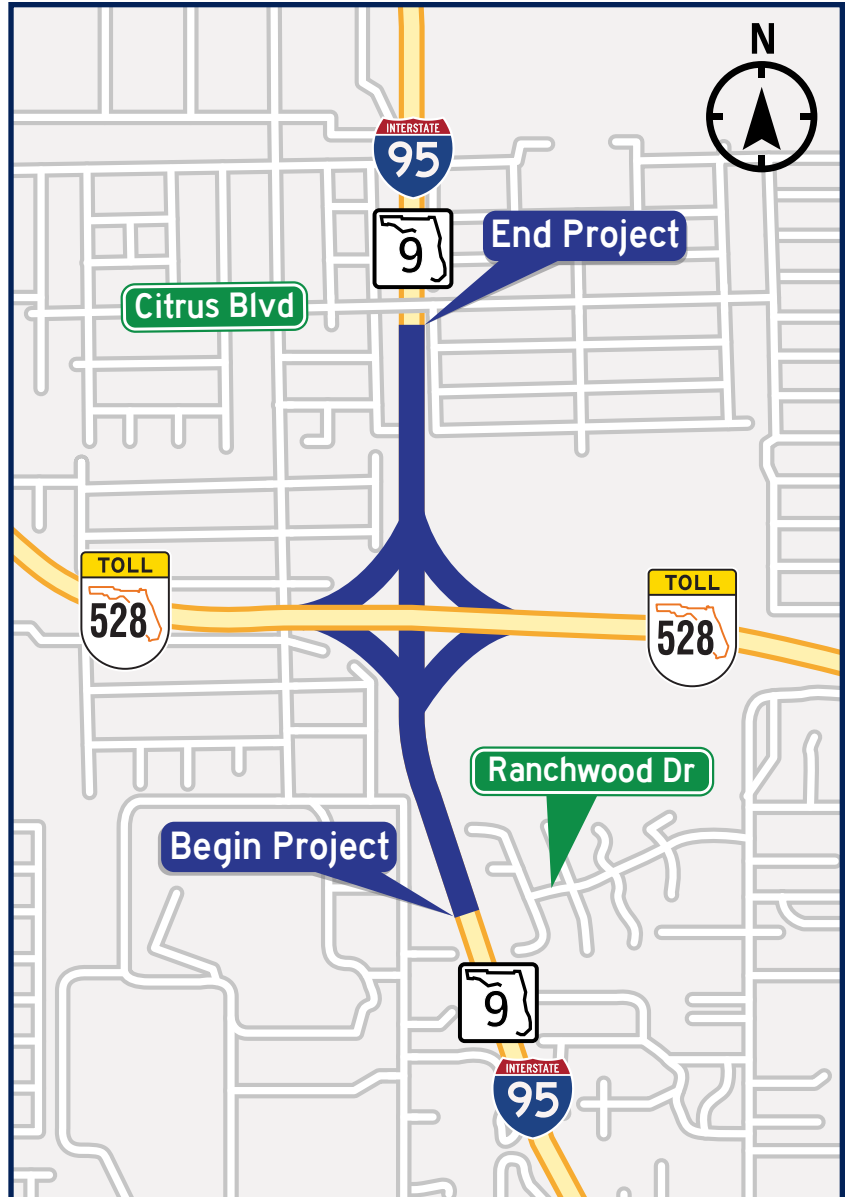

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements along Interstate 95 (I-95) from points 1 mile south to 1 mile north of State Road (S.R.) 528 between the cities of Cocoa and Titusville in Brevard County. The purpose of the project is to improve roadway conditions by resurfacing the asphalt pavement to maintain a safe, reliable, and durable driving surface.

The project includes resurfacing all travel lanes, shoulders, and the ramps at the State Road (S.R.) 528 interchange. Additional improvements include evaluating and upgrading highway lighting as needed, refreshing pavement markings, replacing roadway signs as needed, and installing traffic monitoring cameras to support traffic management and operational efficiency.

FDOT will provide advance notice of any temporary lane closures or traffic pattern changes during construction.
