The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on State Road (S.R.) 471 from S.R. 50 to County Road (C.R.) 478 on Thursday, September 23, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to provide a safe pathway for pedestrians and bicyclists by constructing a portion of the South Sumter Trail along S.R. 471 from S.R. 50 to C.R. 478.
