



# Orange & Hansel Avenues from Prince Street to Hoffner Avenue

## Orange County

### Project Description

This project is occurring within the portion of State Road (S.R.) 527 that consists of divided one-way pairs, with Orange Avenue serving southbound traffic and Hansel Avenue carrying northbound traffic. The purpose of the project is to modify the existing roadway from Prince Street to Hoffner Avenue by reducing lane width to enhance bicycle facilities, pedestrian features and aesthetics. Additionally, the on-street parking will be modified to include curb extensions. The project also will resurface the roadway and upgrade sidewalk curb ramps in compliance with requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Proposed improvements are based on recommendations presented in the Orange Avenue Corridor Planning Study (CPS) completed in November 2014, and are being completed in coordination with Orange County. Within the project area, S.R. 527 provides two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, with on-street parking at the median and 4-foot-wide outside bicycle lanes.
