The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Five, is holding a public hearing regarding proposed improvements to State Road (S.R.) 15/600 (U.S. 17-92). The meeting is being held on Tuesday, June 19, 2018 at the Seminole County Public Safety Administration Building. Public Information Meeting – Location Map




This public hearing is being held to inform interested persons of the proposed extension of the existing turn lanes on S.R. 15/600 (U.S. 17-92) to provide a continuous outside turn lane along with intersection improvements on Airport Boulevard at S.R. 15/600 (U.S. 17-92). The new roadway will consist of a 30-foot raised median with 11-foot lanes and a 7-foot buffered bike lane. An additional westbound right turn lane and traffic separator along Airport Blvd. will be added to enhance the functionality and safety of the existing intersection. In addition to these improvements, this project includes:

- Sidewalk and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements
- Safety Modifications to the existing midblock crossing on U.S. 17-92
- Traffic signal upgrades

Information regarding the roadway design will be available at the meeting. FDOT personnel and consultants will be available to discuss the improvements and answer any questions.
