The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding plans for two projects on East Colonial Drive (State Road (S.R.) 50) on Wednesday, March 29, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. The two projects will alleviate localized flooding at the intersection and adjacent properties along East Colonial Drive at Maguire Boulevard, as well as improve and reconstruct the traffic signal at that intersection. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
