

DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

North Woodland Boulevard (U.S. 17-92/S.R. 15/600) from Mandarin Avenue to north of Kentucky Avenue

Volusia County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is implementing drainage improvements on North Woodland Boulevard (U.S. 17-92/State Road (S.R.) 15/600) from Mandarin Avenue to north of East Kentucky Avenue in DeLand, Volusia County, to relieve flooding issues. An underground stormwater bypass system will be constructed to carry excess rain and ground water from this segment of North Woodland Boulevard to a new drainage outfall at the west end of Mandarin Avenue. Drainage inlets will also be added, and the roadway will be resurfaced within the project limits.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The first two phases of construction will take place along Mandarin Avenue. During this time, signage and flagging operations will be used to allow two-way traffic flow during intermittent traffic shifts and roadway closures along Mandarin Avenue.

The final two phases of construction will take place along North Woodland Boulevard between south of Mandarin Avenue and north of East Kentucky Avenue. During this period, the contractor will utilize limited temporary lane closures, road closures, and detours to construct drainage structures and pipes beneath the travel lanes and the median. Upon completion of the drainage improvements, motorists can expect single lane closures throughout the project limits for roadway resurfacing.

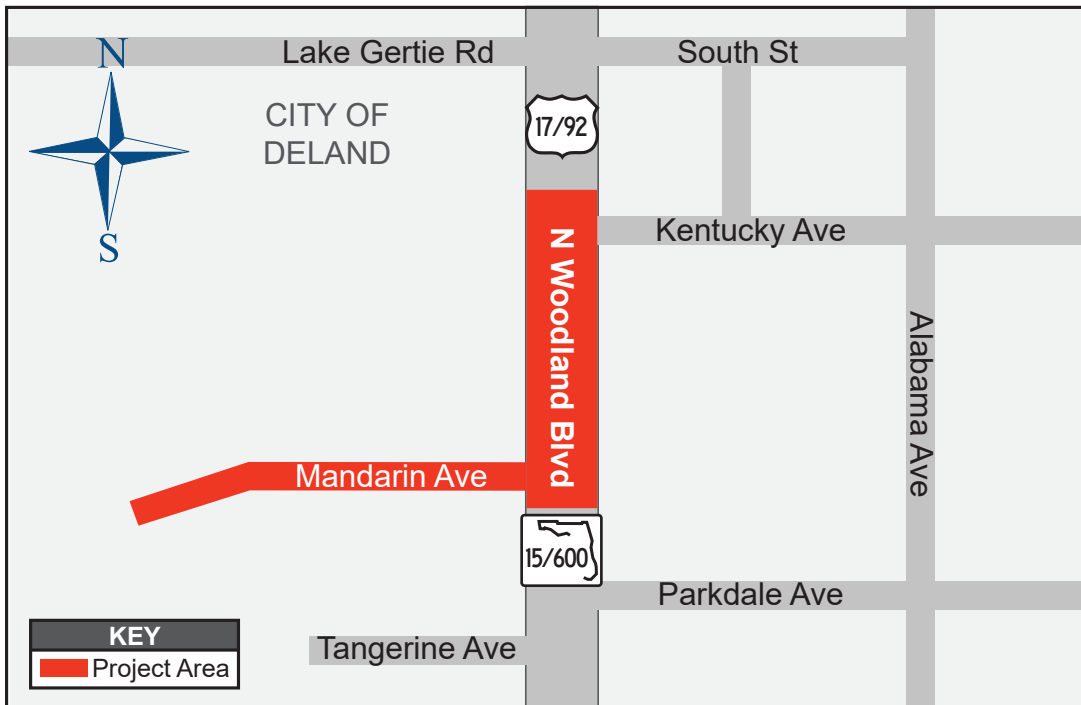
