## MOTORIST AND PEDESTRIAN DETOURS




To reduce needed detour time as much as possible we have incorporated accelerated bridge design techniques.  
**We expect the detour to be in place between 20 and 24 months.**

During the construction of the Barracuda bridge, Barracuda Boulevard will be closed from Middle Way to Quay Assisi.

Residential access will be maintained on Barracuda Boulevard. For all other traffic, a detour is planned utilizing North Causeway and Quay Assisi. This includes residents of Dolphin Cove, Venetian Villas, the community of Venezia, and visitors to the Marine Discovery Center. For those on The Middle Way, no access interruptions are expected; however, navigation to any properties on Quay Assisi will also require the detour utilizing North Causeway to access Quay Assisi. Access to the Marine Discovery Center will be maintained throughout the temporary detour.

## WATERCRAFT DETOURS



**We expect water access to be generally available. However, there will be limited access in the construction zone for safety on occasion.**

During these brief closures, boaters are encouraged to use the channel below North Causeway to access Indian River North. Caution is encouraged as the mean high water vertical clearance, or the average clearance between the water and the bottom of the bridge, is less than the current Barracuda Bridge.
