



ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

Old New York Avenue at Shell Road to close to through traffic June 1.

The Florida Department of Transportation's ongoing project to replace the existing State Road 44 bridge over the St. Johns River will require the closure of Old New York Avenue at Shell Road to through traffic for construction on Tuesday, June 1. This closure will be in place until the bridge construction is complete.


Motorists can continue to access local businesses and residences via Old New York Avenue but the connecting loop to State Road (S.R.) 44/Ed Stone Park will be closed. The Old New York Avenue loop closure will become permanent for the construction of the new S.R. 44 bridge foundation (please see map below).

Those wishing to access Ed Stone Park are encouraged to use the north entrance off S.R. 44. Motorists may continue straight on Old New York Avenue under a low clearance bridge to access Ed Stone Park and local businesses but are advised to pay special attention to the 10-foot-11 inch bridge clearance (see map below).
