

International Speedway Blvd (U.S. 92) Corridor Improvements

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing safety and operational improvements along International Speedway Boulevard (U.S. 92) from the Halifax River Bridge to State Road (S.R.) A1A in Daytona Beach. The corridor improvements include reconstructing and improving the traffic signal at the intersection of International Speedway Boulevard and S.R. A1A and adding turn lanes. The project also would widen International Speedway Boulevard to provide two travel lanes in each direction with a raised median, a 10-foot-wide sidewalk on one side and a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the other. Additionally, the project will reconstruct the traffic signals at Halifax Avenue, Peninsula Drive (S.R. 441), and Grandview Avenue.

The recommended improvements for this corridor are a result of extensive coordination with local and regional agency partners, as well as the public and local communities. A corridor study was completed in 2017 and included a public hearing in February 2017. The City of Daytona Beach passed a resolution supporting the corridor improvements, and a \$750,000 Local Funding Agreement with the City was executed. A design public hearing was held in October 2020.
