I-75 Northbound Rest Area Reconstruction, Marion County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans for the I-75 Northbound Rest Area Reconstruction from north of County Road (C.R.) 484 to south of State Road (S.R.) 200 on Tuesday, May 11, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to update the facility to better serve travelers. Additional parking will also be added for passenger vehicles, recreational vehicles, and trucks. The public meeting is being held to present information and receive community feedback. The FDOT is also designing plans to reconstruct the southbound I-75 rest area. However, construction for the southbound rest area is not yet funded. Additional outreach will take place once the project is funded for construction.
