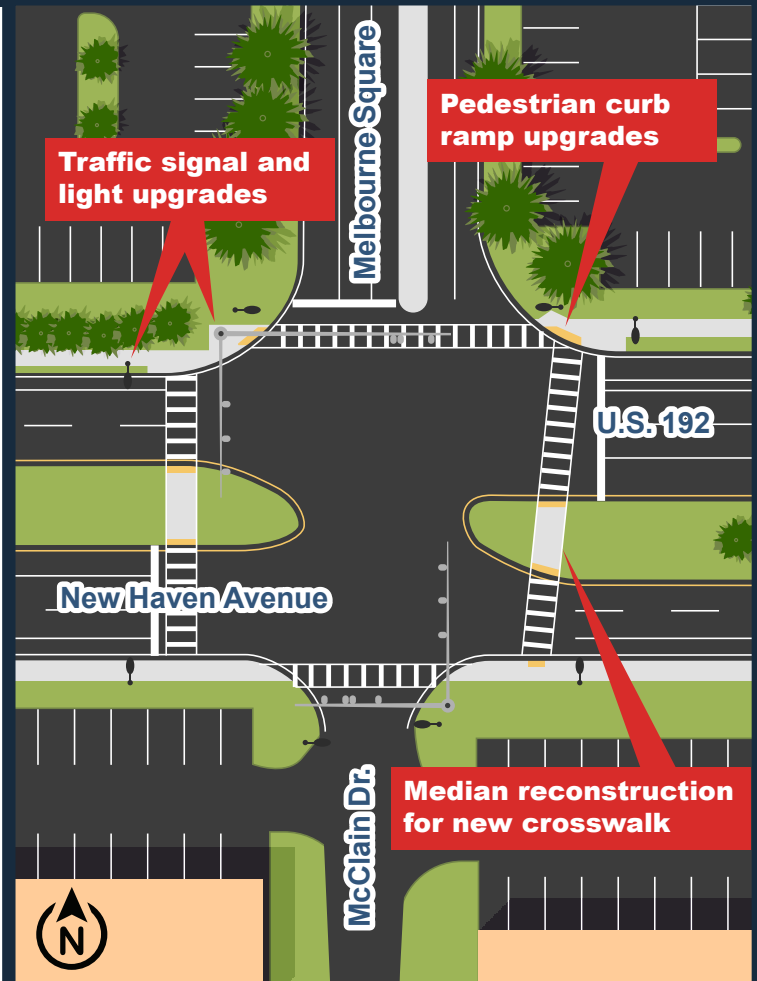

Signal and Intersection Improvements

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) would like to inform the community of proposed roadway improvements at the intersection of New Haven Avenue (U.S. 192) at McClain Drive in Melbourne located in Brevard County. The improvements include upgrading traffic signals with new poles, adding intersection lighting, reconstructing the median on the east side of the intersection to accommodate a crosswalk, and constructing new pedestrian curb cuts and ramps on the east side of the intersection to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The project team is submitting initial plans, and we expect design to finish in July 2021. We invite your comments and questions about this project as we proceed through design. 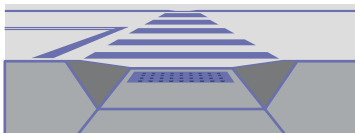

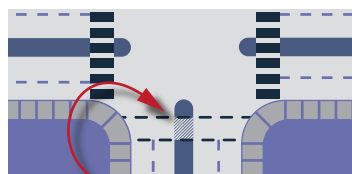
Traffic Signal Upgrades
