## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is making improvements to the intersection of U.S. 1 and Jordan Boulevard in Malabar. Improvements include resurfacing the roadway and upgrading the current traffic signal system of poles and cables to a mast arm system. Other project improvements include minor drainage work, new signage, and pavement markings. Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades to sidewalks and curb ramps will also be completed.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

Throughout the duration of the project, motorists can anticipate daytime and nighttime road work. Nighttime lane closures can be expected between 8 p.m. and 6:30 a.m. for paving operations. Electronic message boards and other signage will help direct traffic through lane closures. Motorists are asked to use extra caution while driving through the work zone. Road conditions during construction are short-term and will become less apparent as the project progresses.
